	IL tabled the SSS Dev Op Plan highlighting the successful return to action after the hiatus of COVID, progress towards a rounded equality profile of sports club members, good levels of engagement with the membership and a growing area of influence within Active Sport & Health. JT highlighted that he felt more could be performed with Mentors, both from a Sabbatical Sports Officer point of view but also for Development officer across the sector. IL agreed to consider this area of work for 22/23 AI noted that Strathclyde were working through the HBHM criteria and that some of the actions seemed slightly onerous/no applicable.
