

## **Table Tennis Championships 2022/2023**

**Gym 3 and Dance Studio, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor**

**St Leonard's Land, Edinburgh, EH8 8AQ**

### **Rules and Regulations**

#### **Eligibility and Entry**

- The Championships are open to any fully matriculated students attending SSS affiliated Universities and Colleges
- Due to capacity restrictions, only 6 men singles & 4 men's doubles pairs per institution are guaranteed entry to the championships. There are no entry capacities for the women's championships. See [Entry Guidance](#) for more details
- Doubles pairs must consist of players from the same institution
- Play will be in accordance with the current ITTF rules

#### **Tournament Set-Up and Scoring**

- The singles championships will consist of round-robin group matches followed by a main draw knock-out and Plate knock-out competition
- All singles entrants are guaranteed a minimum of 3 singles matches
- Players in each group will be required to umpire their group's matches.
- The doubles championships will be a ranked draw (Men's and Women's Doubles allowed, no Mixed teams) in knock-out format.
- Each match is played to best of 5 sets and each set is up to 11 points with two serves each in turn. If players are tied at 10-10, the player must win by 2 clear points. From 10-10 onwards, both players get one serve each in turn.

#### **Equipment**

- Balls will be provided by Scottish Student Sport
- White t-shirts SHOULD NOT be worn in order to ensure clothing is clearly different from the 40mm white ball in use (ITTF regulation). Clean rubber or similar soled (not black) footwear must be used
- One surface of the bat must be black with the other surface conforming to the ITTF permitted colours. No bats will be provided.
