

Scottish Student Rifle Aberdeen and RGU Grand Prixes

Last weekend saw a very successful start to the SSS Rifle GP series, with around 40 competitors each day.

Aberdeen GP:

A Class was won by Megan Auld of St Andrews, with Eden Roy (STA) in 2nd and Robin Shand (RGU) in 3rd. For B Class, Lada Lotova (RGU) won on count-back, with Hao Luo (EDI) in second place and Calvin Findlayson (ABD) in 3rd.

The Novice competitors put in a fantastic showing for their first GP, with Andrej Makarov (EDI) winning, Tabitha Saunders (STA) and Cindy Yu (EDI) in second and third respectively.
