**Equipment Regulations:** The following brush types may not be used for sweeping purposes: brushes with any form of stiffening insert, Hardline original IcePads, Balance Plus Black, Balance Plus EQ+, hair head brooms, no corn brooms. Hair headed brooms and corn brooms may be used as sliding devices only.

**Draw and/or Format:** Players will be mixed into teams and play 2, 4 end games.

**Warm Up:** There will be time before the game to give players time to warm up. Players should bring their own curling shoes/brushes, however for those without brushes and sliders will be provided.

**Medals and Ceremony:** There will be an award ceremony after the meal at 5pm

**Changing Room access:** There are both male and female changing rooms at the ice rink
