

## Terms & Conditions

---

1. Where an institution does not make payment for Scottish Student Sport events it is the responsibility of the individual/team participating in that event to make full payment.
2. If an individual/ team pulls out of an event **after the stated event entry deadline** they will still be charged – except in exceptional circumstances. These could be:
  - If a local lockdown is imposed by the Scottish or UK government which would prohibit an individual/ member of a team from attending the event, and where applicable they cannot be replaced, the institution will not be charged the fee. However, they will still be charged a card processing fee. SSS may require proof of where the individual is living that would place them in the local lockdown
  - If an individual member of a team has developed COVID-19 symptoms or is isolating and therefore cannot attend the event, and where they are not able to be replaced, the institution will not be charged the respective entry fee(s). However, they will still be charged for a processing fee. SSS may require proof that the individual has notified their Athletic/Sports Union
  - If SSS decides to cancel an event due to unprecedented circumstances, the institution and or individual will receive a full refund.
3. If an individual/ team pulls out of an event **before the stated event entry deadline** they will receive a refund, however, they will be charged a card processing fee.
4. Individuals participating in Scottish Student Sport events consent to their photograph being taken or being video recorded, by a representative of Scottish Student Sport.

These photographic images/videos may be used in promotional materials for Scottish Student Sport, both in print and digital media - including social media. Images/videos may be shared within the education sector for promotional materials both in print and digital media - including social media. Consent will remain valid until an individual advises us otherwise. 5. Individuals participate in Scottish Student Sport events at their own risk and no responsibility



whatsoever shall be attached to any event sponsors, directors or any person involved in the organisation of the event for any injury, accidents, loss or damage suffered by an individual in, or by reason of the event, however such may be caused.

6. In regards to COVID-19, is it the responsibility of the student, official or individual taking part to make sure they do not have the following:
- A high temperature, fever or chills (shivering) – this means feel hot to touch on the individual’s chest or back (you do not need to measure the individual’s temperature)
  - A new, continuous cough – this means coughing for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if the individual usually has a cough, it may be worse than normal)
  - A loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means the individual has noticed that they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
  - Been ill with any of the above symptoms in the last 7 days
  - Someone in their current household has been ill with any of the above symptoms in the last 14 days, or have has been in close contact with a definite confirmed case of coronavirus in the last 14 days, or have been contacted by the NHS track and trace system
  - An individual is waiting on a result of a COVID–19 test
  - An individual has travelled internationally and returned to the UK in the past 14 days from a country outside the Government’s current common travel area
  - An individual has knowingly been in contact with any person who has returned from a country outside of the Governments current common travel area in the last 14 days

Should any competitor/official arrive at an event and fail or refuse to take the event health assessment, they will be asked to leave and will not be granted a refund/reimbursement. Refunds/reimbursements will only be given in exceptionally circumstances.
