**Information**

**Entry Cost:** £10 per archer

**Entry Deadline**

Individuals need to enter via the SSS Playwaze system by **4pm on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2022**

**Eligibility**

All archers must be a fully matriculated student with an Institution of Higher Education (University or College) in Scotland. Guest entries will not be taken in this competition, as it is the first back after the pandemic and we wish to ensure all students have their competitive opportunities

**Entry Numbers**

Clubs are Guaranteed places for up to 5 archers, although may enter up to 4 as 'Non-Guaranteed' (who will be accepted by random draw to fill remaining spaces).

**Please note:** your **Sports Unions** will need to know who your Guaranteed and Non-Guaranteed shooters are as they have permissions on the system to make those selections by the deadline of **4pm on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2022.**

**Payment:**

As there are set capacity limits set per institution for this event, the system is set up to invoice your Sports Unions for the total entries we receive per club. These invoices will be sent in the week following the Championships.
