Meet Information

EVENTS

- Individual** 50m events in all strokes with top 6 progressing to finals swum at the end of the session.
100m events in all strokes, heat declared winner.
- Mixed 200m** Swimmers will enter their 200m times through Playwaze and confirm their chosen stroke (Free, Back, Fly, Breast or IM) at the recorders table upon arrival. Race will be seeded based on entry times irrespective of gender & stroke. Results will be ranked based on FINA points & BPS Points.
- Relays** 4 x 50 metre Medley and Freestyle Relays
- Para Swimmers** Para Swimmers are invited to enter any of the above events. There will be separate awards for MC category in the 50m & 100m events based on British Para-Swimming Points (BPS). In the Mixed 200m event as BPS & FINA points are both calculated using worlds standards there will not be separate awards. This year there will not be a separate MC Relay event or category. If you have any specific requirements e.g. Strobe light, use of “tappers” etc. please contact [Cameron Brodie](#) or [SSS](#) in advance of the event.
- Medley Skins event** The Men’s and Women’s 50m Medley Skins event is open to all. There will be prizes for the winning male and female of each category. Qualification to the Medley Skins finals is *through the 100m IM event*. There is no additional cost for the Medley Skins beyond the entry fee for the 100m IM.
1. The fastest six males and females will qualify for their respective SKINS FINAL.
 2. The qualifiers will be spearheaded.
 3. Each race will consist of a 50m sprint.
 4. Each length will have a 2 minute turnaround.
 5. The stroke will be dictated by a ‘blind pick’ from a bag.
 6. The starter will ‘pick’ the first stroke of each final.
 7. The first start will be a conventional start (take your marks.)
 8. The last swimmer in each race will be eliminated.
 9. The eliminated swimmer will then ‘blind select’ the stroke that the following race will swim.
 10. Each race thereafter will be started by way of ‘10 second warning’ by way of whistle, followed by the starting signal for a go (no take your marks!)
 11. After 5 rounds the person ‘still standing’ is the winner.

Judges word is final!

Whilst the 100IM will form part of any cumulative scores for Top Club, the FINAL will not draw any additional points – ITS FOR FUN!

AWARDS AND PRESENTATIONS

- Medals:** Medals will be awarded to the top 3 in each event (excluding the 50m IM skins event) according to the SSS medal policy (a medal must be won in order to be awarded i.e. bronze is only awarded if there were 4 in the race). Presentations for the events held in each session will be held at the end of each session.

Top Club: The trophy will be awarded to the club that gains the most overall points throughout the competition as follows: Individual 1st 6 pts, 2nd 5pts, 3rd 4pts... 6th 1pt. Relays 1st 12pts, 2nd 10pts... 6th 2pts.

ENTRY FEES

All swimmers must be Sports Union members (via a Student Club membership) or a member of Scottish Swimming, for insurance purpose.

Closing date Closing for entries 4pm on 27th January 2023.

Seeding: Heats will be seeded in ascending order of entry time (i.e. slowest go in first heat). The meet organiser reserves the right to seed irrespective of gender if necessary.

Timekeepers: In order that the meet can proceed smoothly each Club **must** provide at least 1 Timekeeper. Please provide the name of this individual on this [FORM](#) by midnight on **22nd January 2023**.

Gala Conduct: To be swum under SASA rules

Pool: 6 Lane 25 metre with anti-wave lane ropes

Timing: Manual timing will be in operation
